1. Successfully completed a course of instruction on Electrical Fitter for 52 weeks at Electrical and Instrument Training Institute Air Force on 10 Nov 1980.

2. During this training following subjects are covered :-

(a) Academic Training:- Mathematics, Phy-

sics. Theory of Flight, Engineering Drawing, Electricity and Magnetism including remote control systems.

(b) **Basic Workshop Practice :-** Identification of metals, use of precision tools heat treatment of metals, layout and use of blue prints, drilling and anti-corrosion treatment, Soldering brazing and Silver soldering, grinding lathe work etc.,

(c) **Electrical Measuring Instruments :-** This includes various types of testing instruments like Meggers, Bonding testers, Avometer of moving coil type, various types of other electrical measuring instruments like ammeters, voltmeters, watt-meters, frequency meter, synchroscope, power factor

meters based on moving coil moving iron, hot wire and thermocouple principles.

(d) **Electronics :-** Basic electronics, valves and transistors, amplifiers and oscillators and various other electronic equipment so as to enable him to work and carry out servicing on any electronic equipment pertaining to his trade.

(e) **DC and AC Machines, Transformers and Connecting Machinery :-** This includes DC and AC motors and alternators and their associated control equipment, transformer and rectifiers etc.,

(f) **Ignition Equipment :-** Servicing and care of magnetos used on the aircraft and

Ground equipment. High energy and high frequency ignition units, Faults finding and rectification of various ignition eqpt

(g) Accumulators :- Care and maintenance of Lead acid and alkaline accumulators, initial and routine charging and capacity testing of accumulators.

(h) Airfield and Ground Equipment :- The training includes airfield lighting, lay-out land mark beacon, flood light and power trailers.

(i) Generation, Transmission of Electrical Power :- Petrol and diesel generating power generating sets, lay out of charging rooms its management and administration, refri-

geration airconditioning etc.,

(j) MT Electrical Equipment :- Overhauling and re-conditioning generators, starters and other electrical accessories of common user Mechanical Transport and specialist vehicles like cranes and fire tenders, fault rectification and servicing procedures.

(k) Electrical Armament Equipment :- Servicing bomb and rocket release circuit, gun firing installation as used on various Air Force Aircrafts and its maintenance.

(l) Aircraft Electrical Installation, Aircraft Servicing and Tech. Administration This includes various types of wiring systems used on aircraft, circuit testing

and fault location, technical organization, orders and instructions in the Indian Air Force, recording of aircraft servicing, airfield procedure, aircraft salvage procedure, equipment procedure, packing and preservation of electrical equipment, defect report procedure etc.,

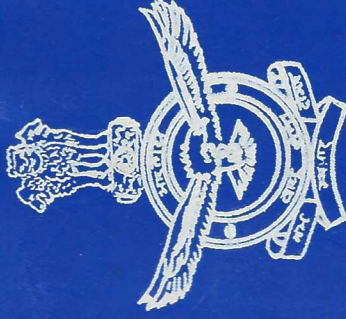
