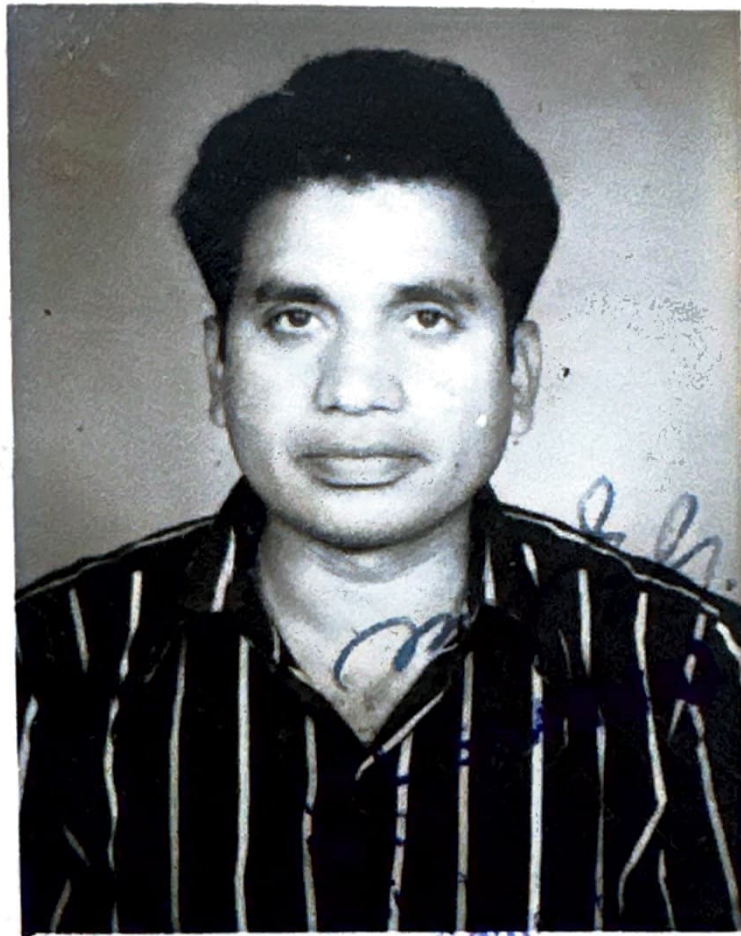

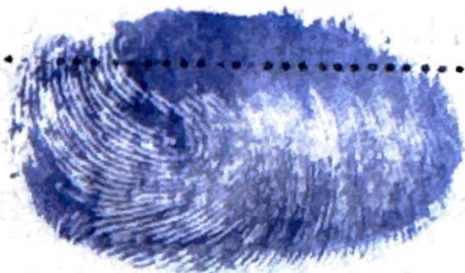

Theory of mechanics, electricity and magnetism covering primary and secondary cells, D.C. Motors, and generators, Transformers, A/C theory, Principles of operation of operation of various types of measuring instruments.

(b) Radio Theory- Thermionic emission, construction of valves, characteristics and analysis of valves parameters, Crystals and transistors and their applications. Practical wiring of power units, amplifiers. Transmission lines and aerials used with Radio transmitters and receivers.

(c) Radar Theory- Principle and application of pulse modulation and CW systems, wave form generators employing CR and LR circuits, Construction, function and application of electrostatic and electromagnetic cathode ray tubes and displays. Servo Mechanism, aerial tuning gear, and various types of Radar aeriels and reflectors. Operationn of Klystron, microwave techniques covering construction, function and practical application of magnetron, wave guides and joints, radar receivers, parametic amplifiers, travelling wave tube and moving target indicator. Principles of radar transmitters communi-
cation.

(d) Radar Equipment

i) Airborne Radar Equipment-Installation, testing and maintenance of all types of navigational and secondary surveillance radar.

ii) Ground Radar Equipment-Siting installation, testing and maintenance of all types of early warning and ground control interception radar.

iii) Maintenance and practical application of oscilloscopes, signal generators, waves meters, out-put testers, noise generators, and multimeters.

(e) Internal combustion engines- Principles and operationn of Petrol Electric sets and diesel engines.

(f) Aircraft Servicing-First,second and calender servicing and documentation of relevant certificates of air worthiness.
